- (c) Hold professional qualification from a recognized professional body with one year work experience relevant to the subject matter/s of the postgraduate diploma or
- (d) Hold any other Diploma from a recognized University, institution or an equivalent qualification with one year work experience relevant to the subject matter/s of the postgraduate diploma or

- (e) minimum of eight years sustained work experience in recognized institution or work places with strong recommendation on the capacity of the candidate to undertake the programme from the Head of the institution where the candidate works which is considered on a case by case basis by the Faculty of Arts on the recommendation of the relevant Board of Study and the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Arts. AND
- (f) A good working knowledge of English.
