### Guidelines for Extended Abstracts

1. The extended abstract must be original research and not previously presented or published elsewhere.
  2. The author/s should have adhered to ethical norms in conducting the research.
  3. The extended abstract should **not exceed 1000 words** and should be submitted in accordance with the guidelines provided.
  4. The Editorial Committee reserves the right to make alterations to the text of the extended abstract to improve its quality. The deadline for submission of abstracts is **20<sup>th</sup> June 2025**

### **Guidelines for preparation of abstracts**

- (i) The title should be concise and reflect the research conducted. Capital letters should be used only for the first letter in the first word of the title and proper nouns.
- (ii) The text of the extended abstract should **not exceed 1000** words.
- (iii) The author(s)' names and affiliation
  - Capital letters should be used only for the initials and the first letters of the surnames of authors.
  - The address of the Institution/ Department where the work was carried out should be included under the author's name.
- (iv) Standard abbreviations of SI units should be used.
- (v) The extended abstract should be coherent and free of language errors.
- (vi) A maximum of **five keywords** should be provided.
- (vii) Use font "Times New Roman", size 11 with 1.5 spacing on A4 paper.
- (viii) The extended abstract should include **an introduction/ background, overarching objective of the study, key research questions, a brief literature review, methods and methodology, findings/results, and conclusion.**
- (ix) **APA 7<sup>th</sup> style** is recommended for reference.
