Introduction

The practical relevance of sociology in development activities is widely recognized throughout the world today. Graduate studies in sociology essentially contributes to creating sociologists with analytical and applied skills.

The Department of Sociology of the University of Colombo has the expertise necessary to conduct such an advanced graduate studies program. The University of Colombo, the oldest metropolitan university in the country is able to extend its services to a wide range of students coming from within and outside the city.

This course is specially intended to advance the theoretical knowledge of the students with regard to sociological issues.

Course Objectives

- To provide the student with a sound knowledge of theoretical and methodological aspects of sociology
- To improve the students' ability to critically analyse society in its various dimensions.
- To develop sociological insights into current social environments and problems

Course Structure & Duration

The course will be taught over a period of two academic years. The candidates are required to take eight courses. The ninth unit will be the research design formulated as a reading course for which the candidates are expected to work with the supervisor assigned. In the Second year of study students are expected to write a dissertation on a selected topic.

A candidate shall not be permitted to sit for the final examination unless she/he has followed at least 80 percent of the classes held. Classes will be held in the evening and on weekends.

Method of Evaluation

- (i) 50% of marks shall be allocated through a system of continue assessment based on class participation and term papers
- (ii) The minimum pass mark is 50% for all courses and the research design.
- (iii) A candidate who does not satisfy the minimum conditions for a papers in the course shall repeat the exam in two further attempts.

Eligibility

The **entry requirements** are:

(a) B.A. Special Degree in Sociology from a recognized University with at least a second class honours

or

(b) General Degree in Arts with Sociology as a subject with first class or second class (upper division)

(c) B.A. Special Degree in Sociology with a Postgraduate Diploma in a relevant field.

(d) M.A.Q in Sociology and

(e) Postgraduate Diploma in Applied Sociology with at least a Merit Pass

The applicants with the necessary qualifications are required to appear for **an interview** at the department. Final selection of candidates shall be the responsibility of the Department subject to Faculty/ Senate approval.

Medium of instruction will be **Sinhala/English**. However, students will be expected to read extensively in the English Language.
