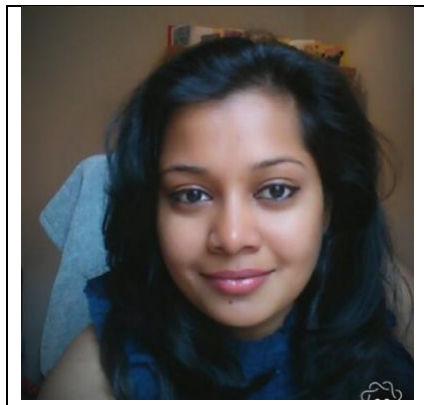
**“That’s not Love but Greed!: Perspectives on

Dr. Tharindi Udalagama completed her PhD at Durham University, United Kingdom in 2018. She was awarded a Commonwealth Scholarship in 2014 to complete her PhD in Social Anthropology. She is also an ‘honorary fellow’ of the Department of Anthropology at Durham University.

Dr. Udalagama is a product of the Department of Sociology, University of Colombo where she completed her Bachelor’s Degree in 2010 with a First Class honours. She was awarded the N.D.S. Silva Memorial prize for Sociology for best performance at the final degree examination in Arts held in the year 2010 by the University of Colombo, Sri Lanka. She is employed as a Lecturer in Sociology at the University of Colombo since 2012. Her PhD thesis is on social suffering of farmer communities in the Mahaweli H system; the oldest system of the Mahaweli Development Program. At this seminar, she will be sharing a chapter from her thesis on how ideas of love and sex are given meaning to by married women within and outside of marriage in a rural village in Sri Lanka.
