2. The Need

Certificate Course in Elementary Chinese Language enables the students who has the basic understanding of Chinese Language to learn creatively and further improve the listening, speaking, reading comprehension and writing abilities. Due to the popularity of Chinese Language all over the world, it will develop the communicative skills by learning language structures, functions and related cultural knowledge.

3. Objectives

The objectives of this Certificate Course are as follows:

- To provide fundamental Chinese sentence structure.
- To develop communication skills in basic topics that is commonly used.
- To master new Chinese characters by figuring out common radicals and strokes.

4. Target Groups

This course is designed for those who has the basic understanding about Chinese and Chinese culture.

5. Admission Requirements

To be admitted as a student of this course, a candidate should possess the following qualifications:

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a) Grade NINE school leaving certificate

AND

b) Pass Certificate Course in Chinese Language for Beginners or corresponding Chinese language certificates accepted by the Confucius Institute at University of Colombo

OR

a) Completion of primary education and certified work experience equivalent to a minimum of two years

AND

b) Be at least 16 years of age

AND/OR, WHERE NECESSARY

c) Passing the admission/selection test and/or interview

6. **Medium of Instruction:** English/Chinese/Sinhala

7. **Course Fee**: Rs. 20,000

8. **Course Duration:** 6 months duration / 60 contact hours

9. Teaching Methodology

- Lectures online/offline
- Group discussion
- home assignments
- Lecturer guided self-studies

10. Evaluation

The evaluation system of the course is made up of four parts: classroom assignments, class attendance, end semester examination and task-oriented activities.
