Short Course in Basic Tamil

1. Introduction

The Colombo Language Centre (CLC) of the University of Colombo seeks the permission of the Senate of the University of Colombo to offer a Short Course in Spoken Tamil.

The courses are expected to commence in July 2022.

2. The Need

In Sri Lanka, there has been a considerable demand for spoken Tamil over the last several decades. Spoken Tamil is seen by many government employees as a second language that can help them secure employment in the permanent cadre and open new career opportunities. Therefore, government employees are now given the opportunity to learn spoken Tamil in government institutions and private institutions for the Official Language Proficiency Examination conducted by the Department of Official Languages.

3. Objectives

At the end this course, students will be able to:

- Write and read simple sentences using the Tamil alphabet.
- Engage in simple day-to-day conversations in Tamil
- Pass the oral test of the Official Language Proficiency Examination conducted by the Department of Official Languages

4. Target Groups

- Those intending to learn Spoken Tamil for the Official Language Proficiency Examination conducted by the Department of Official Languages.
- Those intending to study Tamil for G.C.E. Ordinary Level
- Anyone interested in learning spoken Tamil

5. Minimum Admission Requirements

To be admitted as a student of this course, a candidate should possess any one of the following qualifications:

a) Passed the G.C.E. Ordinary Level examination

AND

- b) be at least 18 years of age

- 7. **Course Fee**: Rs. 25,000
- 8. **Course Duration:** 3 ¾ months (60 contact hours)
- 9. Teaching Methodology: Communicative
- 10. **Evaluation:** Mid-course assessment (15%), End of course assessment (15%), Final examination (70%)
