1. Introduction

The Colombo Language Centre (CLC) of the University of Colombo seeks the permission of the Senate of the University of Colombo to offer a Short Course in Basic Hindi.

The courses are expected to commence in July 2022.

2. The Need

Hindi is the second most widely spoken language in the world, after Mandarin Chinese. There are approximately 370 million native speakers and about 120 million people who speak Hindi as a second language. In the universities of many developed and developing countries, courses on Hindi are offered. In Sri Lanka, Hindi language has been taught for nearly 25 years. This course has been designed for anyone who is interested in learning Hindi language.

3. Objectives

At the end this course, students will be able to:

- Write and read simple sentences using the Hindi alphabet.
- Listen to simple dialogues in Hindi and comprehend them.
- Engage in a simple day-to-day conversations in Hindi

4. Target Groups

- Those intending to start learning Hindi for professional purposes.
- Those intending to study Hindi Language for G.C.E. Ordinary Level or Advanced Level examination.
- Anyone interested in learning Hindi.

5. Admission Requirements

To be admitted as a student of this course, a candidate should possess any one of the following qualifications:

a) Passed the G.C.E. Ordinary Level examination

OR

b) Completion of Grade Nine certificate with certified work experience equivalent to a minimum of two years

AND

- c) be at least 16 years of age
