Competition Guidelines

To celebrate 'UN World Tourism Day 2024', the Sustainable Tourism Unit of the University of Colombo is pleased to announce a 'Video/Short Film Competition'. This competition is open to students from schools, hotel schools, and universities, aiming to explore the role of tourism in promoting peace, cultural understanding, and global harmony.

Eligibility Criteria

The competition is open to three categories:

Category 1: Advanced Level school students (A/L)

Category 2: Students from hotel schools (government and private institutions)

Theme

The central theme of the competition is 'Tourism and Peace – Inclusivity and Prosperity'. Participants are encouraged to creatively interpret the theme and demonstrate how tourism can serve as a powerful tool in fostering peace among nations and communities.

Submission Guidelines

 - o Maximum duration of the video/short film: 2 minutes
- Technical Specifications

o Video Resolution: 1080p

Frame Rate: 25 fpsBit Rate: 8 MbpsVideo Codec: H.264

o Audio: 48000 Hz (192 kbps)

Audio Codec: AACFile Format: MP4

- Number of Submissions
 - o Each participant may submit one video clip.

Submission Deadline

All submissions must be received by 20th October 2024. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Judging Criteria

Films will be judged on the following criteria:

- 1. Relevance to the Theme: How well does the film express the concept of "Peace through Tourism"?
- 2. Creativity and Originality: Innovative approach to the theme and creative techniques.
- 3. Aesthetic Quality: The composition, visual treatment, audio design, and overall artistic and creative execution.
- 4. Message and Impact: The ability of the film to inspire, provoke thought, or promote peace.
- 5. Technical Quality: The technical aspects of the film, including video clarity, sound quality, editing, and overall production values, will be assessed to ensure they meet the required standards for professional presentation.

A panel of judges consisting of veteran film directors, tourism professionals and peace advocates will evaluate all entries.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. The submitted film must be 'original' and must not have been previously exhibited or entered into any other competition. A certification of originality is required, endorsed by one of the following authorities:
 - School students: Teacher In-Charge of the school
 - Hotel school students: Principal of the hotel school

- 5. Any submission that does not adhere to the theme or guidelines may be 'disqualified'.
